September Stir Crazy Fabric Cutlery Roll

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- 2 pieces of 14" x 18" fabric, one for the outside and one for the lining
- 1 piece of 14" x 18" batting
- 1 piece of ribbon 28" long
- 1 piece of 14" double fold bias tape
- Regular thread
- Sewing machine

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Put fabrics right sides together. Add the piece of batting to make a sandwich.
2. Stitch a 1/4" seam on 3 sides, leaving one 14" side unstitched.
3. Clip the 2 stitched corners and turn the sandwich right side out and press.
4. Sew the bias tape onto the open end.
5. With lining facing up, fold the side with the bias tape up 6 inches to make a pocket.
6. Topstitch all around your piece 1/8" to 1/4" wide seam.
7. Check what size pockets you need with your silverware- 2 1/2" wide will work, leaving a wide pocket for your napkins. Mark a straight line and stitch 3 lines.
8. Add a ribbon tie by folding ribbon in half and sewing it on the outside stitch line at the bias tape line.
9. You can make the roll to fit a set of cutlery or one per person.
10. Roll it up and tie it. You now have your cutlery roll!
