

October Stir Crazy Weaving Leaves

Liven up the fall season with colorful woven and painted leaves. Ann will demonstrate how to weave and then paint the leaf. Commercial fabrics may be used instead of painting. Ann is making a small table topper but the leaves could be added to a tote bag, pillow, quilt, a card, or garment.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- 100% cotton fabric that can be torn. If using commercial fabric use one solid or tone-on-tone plus a print.
- One 21"x15" piece of torn black cotton fabric for the fountain
- For the warp Cut one piece of 100% white cotton into a 7" square (for each leaf)
- For the weft Tear at least 13 strips approximately 1/4" to 3/8" wide and 7" long
- Jacquard Textile Color fabric paint (or other acrylic paint) in fall colors.
- · Palette or small container/lids, round paint brush for each color, mist bottle with water
- Sharp scissors/rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and cutting mat (or scissors, a regular clear ruler & pencil)
- Painters, masking, or other tape that can be removed from fabric.
- 7 ½" square of heavy duty foil (for Ann's DIY shuttle)
- Sewing machine (or hand sewing notions)
- White chalk/pencil, or regular pencil that will show on black fabric.
