

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- 3 strips of fabric cut into 2" by 7" rectangles
- 1 or 2 buttons 1/2 in width or less. If using two buttons, make sure the holes line up.
- Needle and thread or hot glue gun
- Regular or decorative thread
- Iron

INSTRUCTIONS

1. To create the triangles, lay a strip of fabric right side up, short end of the rectangle facing you. Fold the bottom corner to the opposite side of the rectangle and line up the edges. The bottom corner should be a point. Continue folding the fabric, until only a small flap of fabric is left.
2. Tuck the flap into the folded triangle like a tab. Press the triangle and repeat with the other two fabric triangles. Press all triangles.
3. To assemble, lay one triangle long side up and the other triangles on either side with the long sides facing out.
4. Place the middle triangle on top of the left triangle.
5. Stack the right triangle on top, aligning the triangles to form a star as shown.
6. Secure with a few hand stitches. Attach the buttons with a needle and thread or a glue gun. Make a loop with the thread and attach to the top of the star.
7. Your star is ready to hang! Enjoy.
