It's that time of the year! Let's celebrate the upcoming holiday season by creating polar bear ornaments! Make one for you or several to share with friends and family.



SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- 10"x14" premium felt
- 10"x14" white fabric (wool, fake fur, blanket flannel)
- Lightweight iron-on interfacing
- Black and white thread or black embroidery floss
- Polyester fiber fill
- Black 1 1/4" grosgrain ribbon
- Scissors, pins, marker, cardstock or cardboard for pattern

INSTRUCTIONS

- Iron interfacing to the wrong side of white fabric.
- Cut felt into four pieces - 5"x 7" each.
- Cut white fabric into 4 pieces - 5"x 7" each.
- Trace bear onto wrong side of white fabric using the template on the following page.
- Cut out bears.
- Mark eye and ear on right side of white fabric.
- Stitch eye and ear using very small stitch gauge or by hand using black floss.
- Center bear on felt and zigzag in place. Leave 1 1/2" opening at top for stuffing.
- Lightly stuff bear with fiber fill.
- Insert loop of grosgrain ribbon behind stuffing and felt. Pin closed.
- Stitch bear closed. Trim away felt so that 1 1/2" of color shows around bears.
- Be careful to NOT cut the ribbon off
